Blending & Recycling Glossary of Terms - page 2

Unclassified Tramp: Any substance not indicated on the SDS or Qdoc01 document that is not previously identified by the customer as Beneficial or Unwanted for inclusion, disposal, and Returnable tramp. CPS will notify customer of any observation of unclassified tramp and seek disposition.

Intermediate Materials: Partially converted items requiring further processing.

Finished Goods: Fully released items that are shipment ready.

Initial Item: Fully released first generation item ready for shipment.

Reworked Item: Fully released second generation item converted from first generation item ready for shipment. (making the same item twice)

Sorting: The removing, segregating, classifying of one or more materials from a raw or reworked items.

Pre-Sorting: The sorting performed as a separate process prior to production or conversion of a raw or reworked material.

In-Line Sorting: The sorting performed as an integrated step in the production or conversion of a raw or reworked item.

Partial Decontamination: The result of sorting unwanted tramp material from a raw material to a percent of efficiency.

Total Decontamination: The result of sorting unwanted tramp material from a raw material to 100 percent efficiency. (Unlikely Outcome)

Trial Campaign: A campaign that meets one of the following “new” conditions: New Raw Materials, New Processes, or New Product Specifications. The objective is to observe and identify potential new characteristics and compensate appropriately.
